The CLA will be holding lunchtime webinar on **Thursday 3 July** at 12:00 pm.

Tom Oliver, Bryce Matthewson, Sara Nazaré and Rien Broekstra have kindly agreed to speak on the following:

Injunctive Relief in European Patent Actions: preliminary injunctions and the effect of BSH

This webinar will explore two key themes shaping the landscape of injunctive relief in European intellectual property litigation: first, the evolving approaches of the UK and Unified Patent Court (UPC) to preliminary injunctions; and second, the implications of the CJEU's recent ruling in BSH v Electrolux on the availability and scope of final injunctive relief.

Tom Oliver is a Partner at Powell Gilbert and specialises in complex intellectual property litigation and strategic counselling. He has an international practice, with extensive experience in devising multi-jurisdictional patent litigation strategies and co-ordinating legal teams across Europe, Asia and North America. In addition to considerable experience before the English courts, Tom has represented clients in several of the first cases brought in the UPC. He advises on the full range of intellectual property rights, including trade mark oppositions and infringement proceedings, confidential information, copyright and passing off.

Bryce Matthewson is a Partner at Powell Gilbert LLP.
